
Math Mondays! March 17, 2025

Use the image to answer Kindergarten and 1st grade questions.





Kindergarten:

How many more four-leaf clovers are needed for each leprechaun in the picture to have one?

1st Grade:

The local parade includes 75 leprechauns. How many more leprechaun's are needed in the picture to have a total of 75? Use words and numbers to support your answer.

2nd Grade:

Before the St. Patrick's Day parade, every participant receives 3 cookies and 1 cup of juice. There are 1000 participants in the parade. Janice claims they need a total of 300 cookies and 1000 cups of juice. Do you agree with Janice's claim? Use words and numbers to support your decision.
